

## Privacy policy

These Terms and Conditions establish the privacy policy and personal information protection for TechGALA Japan (hereinafter referred to as "Event"), which is operated by the Global Event Executive Committee, consisting of the Chubu Economic Federation, Nagoya University, Aichi Prefecture, and Nagoya City (hereinafter referred to as "the Executive Committee").

The Executive Committee is committed to protecting personal information by appropriately handling its acquisition, use, and management in accordance with the "Act on the Protection of Personal Information (Act No. 57 of 2003)." To achieve this, the following personal information protection policy is established.

### Obtaining personal information

The Executive Committee will acquire the following personal information through proper and fair means (enquiry form on this website, newsletter registration form).

- Company/organisation name
- Type of business
- Department name
- Position
- Full name
- Telephone number
- Date of birth
- Gender
- Address
- Email address

The personal information will only be used within the scope of the stated purpose of use.

### Purposes of use of personal information

- To apply for participation in the event.
- To reply to enquiries made to the Executive Committee.
- For various communications and information from the secretariat concerning the event.
- For PR activities (event PR, PR of participating companies).
- To provide information to sponsor companies and to conduct PR activities for sponsor companies.

### Management of personal information

To the extent necessary to achieve the purpose of use, the Executive Committee will maintain the personal information of customers in an accurate and up-to-date form and will take necessary and appropriate measures for the safe management of personal

information, including security measures such as encryption and access restrictions, to prevent leakage, loss or damage of personal information, and will establish a management system. The company has a management system in place.

### Provision of personal information to third parties

The Executive Committee will not handle personal information beyond the scope necessary to achieve the purpose of its use or provide acquired personal information to third parties, except as stipulated by law or with the prior consent of the customer.

### Disclosure to contractors

The Executive Committee and the Secretariat may outsource all or part of the personal information obtained within the scope necessary to achieve the purpose of use. In such cases, the Executive Committee and the Secretariat will select a contractor that is deemed to be handling personal information appropriately, and will make the necessary arrangements in contracts and other agreements to prevent the leakage of customers' personal information through the appropriate management of personal information and maintenance of confidentiality, and will have the contractor implement appropriate management.

### Disclosure, correction, deletion and suspension of use of personal information

The Executive Committee confirms that the customer has the right to request the disclosure, correction, deletion or cessation of use of his or her personal information.

### Period of storage of personal information

The Executive Committee will securely delete or anonymize personal information after an appropriate period of time has elapsed once the purpose for which it was used has been achieved. However, information that is required by law to be retained will be retained in accordance with that law.

### Use of cookies

This website uses cookies and similar technologies to collect certain information for the purpose of improving convenience.

Cookies are small text files containing optional information that are stored on your device and exchanged between the web server and your internet browsing software when you access a web page.

If you have allowed the use of cookies in your browser settings, a cookie will be created by your browser and automatically sent to you when you access this website again. Access information is only used as statistical information. Cookies do not contain any information that can identify you personally.

If you do not wish to accept cookies, you can set your browser to disable the storage of cookies on your computer.

## Compliance with and review of laws, regulations and norms

The Executive Committee will strictly adhere to Japanese laws and other norms applicable to personal information in its possession, and will regularly review its policies and implement appropriate improvements.

## Handling of personal information

### Compliance with GDPR

In accordance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the Company adheres to the following policies and procedures in the handling of personal data.

#### 1. Rights of the data subject

We provide you, the data subject, with the following rights

- Right of access: you have the right to request access to your personal data held by us.
- Right to rectification: you have the right to request correction of inaccurate personal data.
- Right to erasure (right to be forgotten): you have the right to request erasure of your personal data under certain conditions.
- Right to restrict processing: you have the right to request that the processing of your personal data is restricted.
- Right to data portability: you have the right to obtain your personal data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and to transfer it to another controller.
- Right to object: you have the right to object to your personal data being processed for a specific purpose.

## 2. Legal basis for data processing

We will only process your personal data if

- Where we have obtained your consent
- Where it is necessary for the performance of a contract
- Where it is necessary to comply with a legal obligation
- Where it is necessary to protect your vital interests or those of others
- Where it is necessary to carry out a task assigned to us by the public interest or an official body
- Where it is necessary for the legitimate interests pursued by us or third parties. However, this excludes cases where your fundamental rights and freedoms are overridden.

## 3. Data transfer

If we transfer your personal data outside the EU, we will take appropriate safeguards (e.g. standard contractual clauses) as required by the GDPR.

## 4. Response in the event of a personal data breach

In the event of a personal data breach, the Executive Committee will report it to the supervisory authority within 72 hours in accordance with the GDPR and will also promptly notify the customer.

Through these policies and procedures, the Executive Committee is committed to making customer privacy and data protection a top priority. We are committed to continuous improvement and transparency to ensure that our customers can use our services with peace of mind.

## Precautions

### 1. Photography and video recording of the event and its use

Photography and video recording will take place at the event for recording and promotional purposes. By participating in the event, participants agree to the following conditions

#### a. Photography and video recording

Any photographs and videos taken and recorded during the Event ('Content') will be owned and controlled by the Company.

The Content may include portraits of participants.

In addition, Content filmed and recorded by the media participating in the Event may be published as articles or video Content.

#### b. Purposes of use of content

We may use content for the following purposes

- Our promotional activities (e.g. website, social networking sites, brochures)
- Recording and reporting on this event
- Other related marketing activities.

#### c. Consent.

By participating in the Event, participants acknowledge that their likenesses are included in the Content and consent to their use.

Participants shall not object to the Content being used for the above purposes.

d. If the participant wishes to have his/her portrait removed

If a participant wishes to have content containing his/her likeness removed, he/she should contact the contact person. The request for removal should include information that identifies the specific content (e.g. photo number or video clip) that the participant wishes to have removed.

## 2. exemption of the Executive Committee from liability

Your participation in this event is at your own risk. We are exempt from liability under the following conditions

### a. Trouble and damage

The Company shall not be liable for any trouble or damage arising in connection with participation in the Event, unless it is obvious that the damage was caused by the Company's intent or gross negligence.

### b. Trouble between participants

The Company accepts no responsibility for any trouble between participants or visitors, or between speakers, partner companies, media, etc., that occurs at the event, including online exchanges.
